2. TRAVEL INFORMATION

- Travel from Nadi International Airport to Tanoa Int'l hotel**
Shuttle bus from airport to hotel will be available for delegates staying in Tanoa International Hotel. At the arrivals after clearing customs, look for Tanoa International Hotel signature or the Bus outside the arrival hall
- Departure Tax**
Departure Tax of F\$20.00 payable at Nadi Airport on departure. Departure tax are normally included in tickets so just ensure.
- Visa and Immigration Requirements**



All travellers to Fiji must have a valid passport for at least three months of the date of arrival. Please check with your travel agents the appropriate visas and documentation necessary for your entry into Fiji.

4. Climate

Fiji has a tropical warm climate in November; temperatures ranging between 28-32 degrees Celsius; Some cool clothing is recommended and umbrella if staying in alternate hotels.

5. Electricity

Electricity voltage is 240 volts with pin configuration similar to Australia, NZ and most European countries. You are advised to take along your universal adaptor if you are from the USA, Japan or any other country with dissimilar pin configurations and voltages.

6. Currency

Fijian Dollars. International Banks operating in Nadi are Westpac and ANZ. Their Buying Exchange rates is approximately F\$1.00: US\$0.53
Major Credit Cards accepted at the hotel and other major outlets and ATMs.

7. Time

Local time in Fiji is GMT +12hrs (00.00)

8. Internet

Internet access will be provided on conference site (wifi and Internet fixed access points)
